Reviewed Profit & Loss Statement and Balance Sheet- Reviewed current rates on utilities were discussed. Commission will like to see some suggested relief so we are financially secure next year.

Well head protection plan progress was reported by Spaeth. We will be working to complete the plan by November 2020. Guidance is being gathered from MDH and MRWA. Spaeth commented on well tests performed that were conclusive that our water is vintage and has not seen any human influence to the aquifer. Protecting that water is a priority.

Bill Berg presented equipment on Auction website closed and a few HMU items were not sold and will be scrapped.

Property discussion acquisition and sale of rock. Information supplied by Julin law office was discussed. Aggregate sale to more than one buyer was discussed with an understanding that the bed be in good shape after rocks are removed.

Superintendent Report- Spaeth updated Commissioners on City projects with streets and levee work. Some additional infrastructure needs being improved with the extensions of both water and sewer mains to new General Store.
