Johnson Jetline clean and camera sanitary sewer in Furseth field south side of Halstad Fall 2020. Spaeth added they did have some areas that were Approval Motion Gotteberg Second Johnson for additional maintenance this year. M/C

Spaeth presented that the State was offering 10,000 grants for source water protection. Motion to approve grant Maroney Second Johnson. M/C

Superintendent report given by Spaeth; Brought up equipment sale from a local contractor and the Commission ability and need for adding underground equipment to assets.
