Free Lot Application Process



- 1. Applicant completes the Free Lot application form and submits the form to the City Clerk and provides proof of pre-approval.
 - a. The City will require a letter from the applicant's lender indicating they are preapproved for a loan to finance the cost of constructing the planned home.
 - b. The applicant will indicate the desired lot on the application form.
 - c. The applicant must make available to the council all blueprints associated with the new house, which must have an assessed value of at least \$175,000. The council will give approval if the blueprint designs can be built upon a free lot.
- 2. City Council Reviews application and required documents.
 - a. Application form and plans are reviewed.
 - b. Council approves application and directs the Clerk to work with the applicant and City Attorney on a purchase agreement and quit claim deed.
- 3. City Attorney prepares a purchase agreement, and the applicant, Mayor, and Clerk sign the purchase agreement and quit claim deed.
 - a. The applicant will be required to sign a purchase agreement and quit claim deed.
 - b. The applicant is responsible for their own closing costs relating to the property purchase (i.e. title insurance premium and commitment, State deed tax, recording fees, title agent) closing fees, etc.)
- 4. Obtain necessary approvals.
 - a. Halstad City Council must approve the purchase agreement and quit claim deed at the next regular City Council meeting.
- 5. Complete construction.
 - a. If an applicant has not completed constructing approved dwelling within 18 months from the date of purchase for a single-family lot, ownership of the property and any improvements will revert back to the City and/or the lending institution in accordance with the signed purchase agreement and quit claim deed.
 - b. Extensions may be considered by the City Council by request of the property owner.
 - c. Building permit renewals and extensions are the buyer's responsibility.
- 6. The applicant shall be relieved of paying City taxes associated with the free lot for a period of 5 years upon meeting all other requirements.
 - a. The recipient must apply for abatement of City tax each year by requesting abatement in writing to the City of Halstad.
 - b. The City Treasurer will contact the County Auditor/Treasurer to remove City tax for the year indicated in the request.
- 7. Commencement of payment of special assessments, if any, shall be deferred for a period of 2 years. The City Treasurer will notify the County Auditor/Treasurer when the 2 years have been reached.
